STAGE AND SCREEN, BA COMBINED MASTER'S DEGREES

Program Requirements

The Stage and Screen Program and the College of Business offer two combined Bachelor's and Master's degrees in which students earn a Bachelor of Arts in Stage and Screen (BASS) and a Master Degree in either Business Administration (MBA) or Strategic Leadership Development (MSLD) within five years.

The graduate courses will be taken as part of the 18 free electives offered in the BA in Stage and Screen program.
